Impersonation Accounts and Finstas

An Impersonation Account is when someone sets up an Instagram account (or other social media account) pretending to be you. The point of this is generally to make trouble and it is considered cyber-bullying, an abuse of our acceptable use of technology policy, and in the bigger world, can lead to legal prosecution. A Finsta (Fake Instagram) is a second account used to share with a smaller group of followers and is usually private. It's a place where kids might just be sillier, or it might be an account they don't want a parent to know about. Since it is deliberately more private, it might be a place where kids say things they shouldn't to one another, or about other students. Check out [this article](#) for more information.

Recently, I have been looking into a situation where someone impersonated another student on Instagram. Photos from the student's real account were copied to create a fake one with a close-enough user name, and understandably, this was embarrassing. It was a violation of our student's online identity.

Please monitor your child's online use carefully. Fortunately, in the case I've mentioned, the impersonated student's device is actually a parent's, and the parent is very aware of who follows the student's accounts, and what is shared. **Are you as savvy?** Please take measures, if you haven't already, to know **all** of your child's accounts and passwords, to understand how to find Finstas, or other harder-to-find online activity, and to randomly check your child's use of social media. Although we actively teach cyber citizenship, your child's safety and internet behavior is ultimately dependent on your vigilance.
