- Our annual tuition raffle will occur at Open House. One current family and one new family will win a tuition grant, but all entries are submitted at the Open House.
- Your help at Open House is welcome. Please pay attention to any specific requests that are made regarding volunteers. We will need representation from various aspects of our school community such as scouts, sports, clubs, etc. We will use friendly greeters and parents willing to welcome and engage new families.
- Most of all...we need you to invite a family to visit our Open House. The quality of our community is a testament to the people who choose St. Bernadette. Think about the child you'd like in your child's class, or the friend you'd like to have as a school parent. Invite them, please. Word of mouth is the best tool we have!

New Tuition Grant Opportunity – Deadline approaching

The Archdiocese of Cincinnati has a new division supporting Catholic education, the <u>Catholic Education Foundation</u>. The Foundation will be awarding need-based grants to qualifying families, *regardless* of parish affiliation. To qualify for consideration, families must **complete the Facts Grant and Aid Assessment by January 31, 2017. <u>This link will take</u> <u>you to the assessment.</u> Grant amounts will vary, but will not exceed \$1,000, and can be applied to any Catholic school. Families do not need to be Catholic.**


