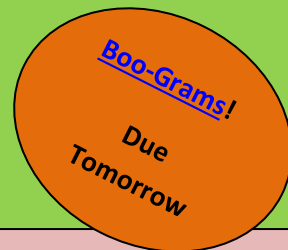


Announcements
