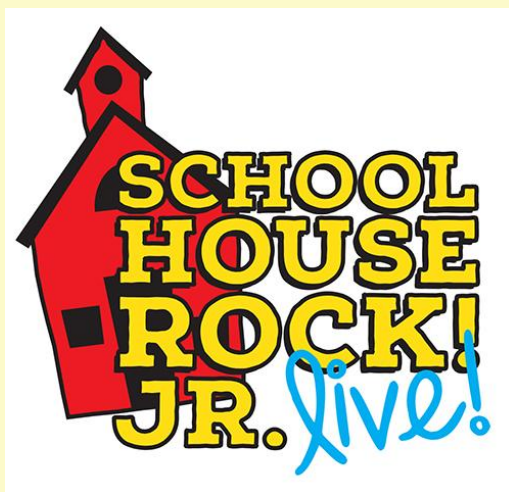

GRAND RAFFLE CHALLENGE

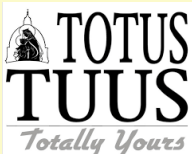
