



Returning this summer! **TOTUS TUUS**, Latin for "Totally Yours," is a week-long summer catechetical youth program that combines Catholic religious instruction and having FUN!!! A team of college-age students and seminarians are coming to the parish the week of July 20<sup>th</sup> – 26th. The youthfulness and energy of the teachers are an inspiring

way to share the faith and their enthusiasm is contagious, so come out and join us!!! TOTUS TUUS is Monday - Friday 9:00 AM - 2:30 PM for school children going into grades 1-6. The day includes catechetical instruction on our theme – the Sacraments and Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary, songs and skits that are silly but teach the faith, encounters with the sacraments, particularly Confession and Eucharist, and time for games and recess. For teens, those entering 7 - 12 grades, a teen program of TOTUS TUUS is Sunday-Thursday 7:00 PM - 9:00 PM with more in-depth discussions on our theme.
