Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are into the winter features of our dress code. A few reminders:

- No shorts may be worn to school as of November 1.
- Boys must be wearing long khaki pants until April 15.
- Girls may wear long khaki pants, or their plaid uniform.
- Girls may wear tights (opaque hosiery) in solid white, navy or black under a uniform.
- Girls may wear plain black leggings under a uniform. Ankles must be covered.
- Yoga pants, athletic pants, sweat pants, etc. are not permitted.
- Belts must be worn on pants with belt loops for both boys and girls.
- Boys' haircuts should not include austere or decorative shaving with a contrasting hair length on top, down the back, etc. If your son has recently purchased such a haircut, please refrain from renewing it.
- Girls may wear boots designed for indoor wear in cold weather months. They must be neutral in color, free of ornamentation or elaborate buckles, with a solid sole, and no heel.
- Hoodies may not be worn in the classrooms.

The Seventh Grade is leading our food drive efforts this year as their act of service. They will be announcing incentives and goals for donating canned goods and boxed goods to our St. Vincent DePaul food pantry. *SEVEN DAYS OF GIVING* begins next week, where our entire school will be encouraged to bring in items in preparation for the Thanksgiving holiday.
