Dear Parents and Guardians,

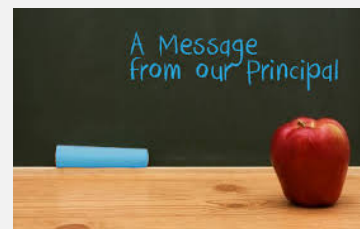
Conferences are fast approaching and we will be sending out a link to the Sign-Up Genius for conference appointments sometime tomorrow.

As mentioned in our Meet The Teacher meeting, some of our conferences are student-led this fall.

The 7th and 8th grade teachers are piloting a few of these (parents have been invited already) and there may be another teacher here or there who wants to try it this month with a few students. Ultimately we want student-led conferences to be the norm at St. Bernadette. Preparing for them helps students think about their school experience, their goals, their effort, and their triumphs. We also rehearse with students' and build their ability to talk about their schoolwork with their parents; this helps develop leadership skills and accountability.

One challenge with student-led conferences is that they need more teacher time on the front end of the process, and they may take a little longer than the typical 10 or 15 minute conference time slot. Our goal is to make all spring conferences student-led, and for all students to have a conference experience like this. To that end, we may be adjusting the spring conference schedule, or spreading conferences out over several days or even weeks. The faculty and I will be pursuing solutions for the greatest possible good. If we come up short on an almost-perfect solution, we will revamp fall conferences for 2020 with the goal in mind.

Please consider: *If you need a conference to discuss a special issue about your child, or to troubleshoot a complex situation, you may need to request a separate conference day and a longer conference time. Contact your child's teacher directly to set something like that up. Conferences on October 29 and 30 are for simpler,*



more routine reporting.

Anticipated delivery date: Second week of December.



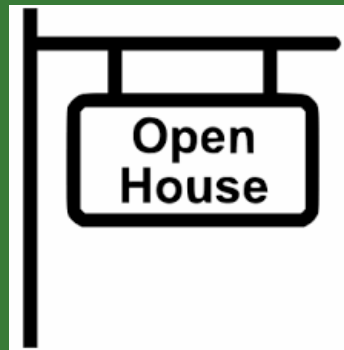
FAMILY BOWLING NIGHT
