Dear Parents and Guardians,

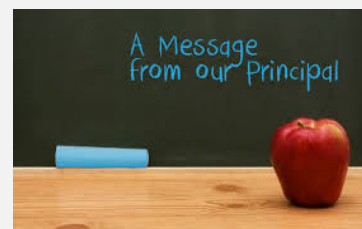
We had a very successful round of parent conferences this week. I will be sending out a survey to get your feedback about the experience soon.

We will be creating a slide show and need your help.

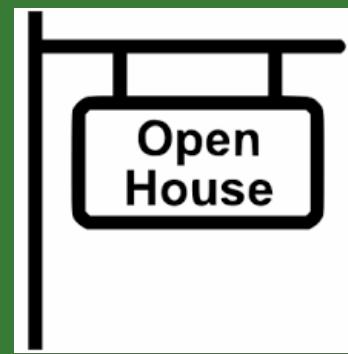
