In addition to the above-named awards, I will announce groups of students to "Stand and be recognized" for going above and beyond in the AR program or for being named as a Student of the Month in our Virtues In Practice program. Eighth grade students will be invited to stand in these groups, too, and will be blessed and applauded out of the church. Their actual certificates and awards will be announced and given at graduation on May 31st. Certificates for AR or virtues are handled separately from the named awards.

We value all of our students, and yet we know that most children will not receive an award on May 29. Please take a little time between now and then to help your child understand this process, and help him or her be ready to cheer on the awardees in their homeroom. Our teachers will do the same.

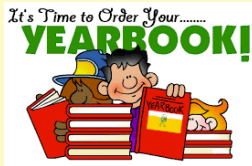

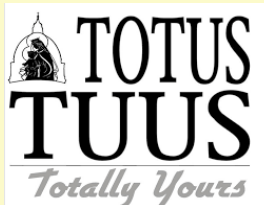

Returning this summer! **TOTUS TUUS**, Latin for "Totally Yours," is a week-long summer catechetical youth program that combines Catholic religious instruction and having FUN!!! A team of college-age students and seminarians are coming to the parish the week of July 20<sup>th</sup> – 26th. The youthfulness and energy of the teachers are an inspiring

way to share the faith and their enthusiasm is contagious, so come out and join us!!! TOTUS TUUS is Monday - Friday 9:00 AM - 2:30 PM for school children going into grades 1-6. The day includes catechetical instruction on our theme – the Sacraments and Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary, songs and skits that are silly but teach the faith, encounters with the sacraments, particularly Confession and Eucharist, and time for games and recess. For teens, those entering 7 - 12 grades, a teen program of TOTUS TUUS is Sunday-Thursday 7:00 PM - 9:00 PM with more in-depth discussions on our theme. All parishioners are invited to a potluck dinner on Wednesday, July 24th at 5:30 PM. Cost per child (per family) is \$10 (\$25).
