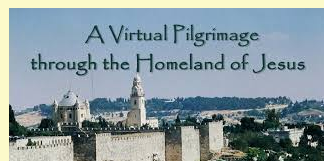

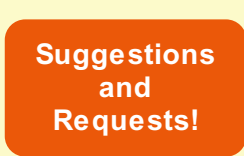
GOLF OUTING
