

Dear Parents and Guardians,

PICTURE DAY

Pictures will be taken here at school this Friday, September 18. Picture envelopes arrived today. Please check your child's back pack today or tomorrow for yours. If you'd like to pay for your photos before Picture Day, log onto mylifetouch.com and use our ID: **EVTCNZ4DM**

WHAT TO WEAR: Picture Day is considered a dress-up day. All clothing must be modest, clean and in good repair.

For boys: Dress shirt or nice polo (plain), dress pants, uniform slacks or dress shorts or uniform shorts. No athletic wear or jeans. No t-shirts, tanks, etc., and no slogans or images. School shoes/gym shoes are fine.

For girls: Dress blouse, knit top or nice polo with dress slacks or uniform pants. Dresses, skirts or dress shorts may be worn at a modest length (just above the knee). No t-shirts, tanks, spaghetti straps or shirts short on the torso and no slogans or images. School shoes/gym shoes are fine and no heels or flip-flops, but sandals secure on the heel and toe are okay.

Students wearing their school or scout uniform for Picture Day. If a student opts to wear the school uniform or scout uniform, he or she may have an out-of-uniform day on MONDAY. Teachers will report to Mrs. Ingram which students qualify for an out-of-uniform pass for Monday. Students out-of-uniform on Monday may wear modest, casual clothing. No athletic wear, but jeans are okay. No shirts with slogans or images.

Be sure you are ordering lunches for the correct day(s), and that your orders are in well before the deadline. We have had a few missed lunches this week. **Please consider ordering lunch the night before, and double check the day for which you are ordering.**

To order lunch, go [HERE](#). The daily option link on the order form should take you to the K-5 Amelia Elementary menu.


Some additional notes:
