

## Tuesday, August 23

All classrooms will be open from 1:00-6:30. You are welcome to come in and see your child's classroom. ## Wednesday, August 24 First Day of School!

Children will gather on the black top by the playground from 7:30-7:55. At 7:55, children will lineup with their homeroom teachers and move to the gym for our Opening Day Assembly. Any parents who are on the premises are encouraged to form lines on either side of the gym sidewalk and clap hands as our students are led into the gym. Parents may stay for the first part of the assembly, take a photo or two, and Mrs. Ingram will dismiss you from there. Students are in regular uniforms on the first day of school.

Kindergarten students will be dismissed at 11:00 on Wednesday. There is no bus

Pull out the school clothes and make sure your child's uniform fits, is in good condition, (no tears, broken zippers, missing buttons) and that you have uniform polo shirts ready to go.
