## **CLOSE CONTACTS AND QUARANTINING**

*We've had a few cases lately of students being named a "close contact" of someone who tested positive for COVID-19. When that happens, the close contact needs to quarantine for 14 days from the last date of contact with that person. Siblings without exposure do not have to quarantine. So, for example, if a student on a community based team tests positive, only the team members need to quarantine, not the siblings of the team members. The purpose of quarantining is to separate out those who've been exposed from those who have not, and to keep an eye out for the development of symptoms. If symptoms develop over those 14 days, then the quarantined player now goes into isolation (staying away from family members, too) and should be tested.*

## VISION SCREENING

We have received new vision screening equipment for preschoolers, kindergarten and first graders from Prevent Blindness Ohio, and have been trained in the use of this updated equipment and method. The upper grades will continue to be screened with our standard equipment. We will begin vision and hearing screening this Friday, October 9th, beginning with kindergarten. Grades tested this year are K, 1, 3, 5, and 7. Testing will continue until all students in these grades are tested. A form with the test results will be sent home to all parents soon after their

child is tested. New this year - preschool children will have their vision screened. We will begin screening preschoolers in a few weeks. Results will be sent home to parents.
