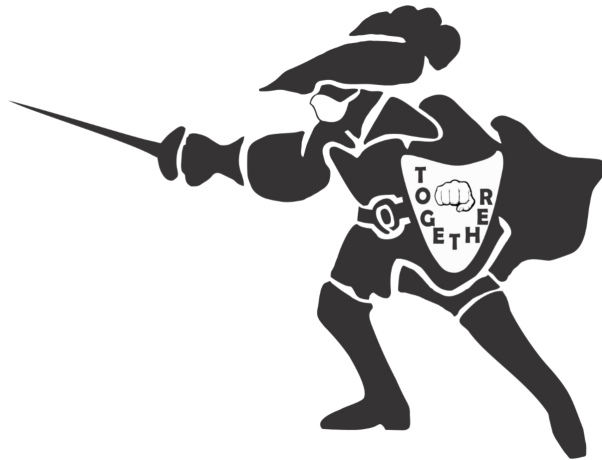

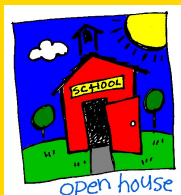

## MEET-THE-TEACHER CLASSROOM WALK-THROUGHS August 24, 5-8 p.m.

### Transportation Information

**As of now, local school districts are able to transport to St. Bernadette.**

If you live in **West Clermont School District**, you can check your route information [HERE](#) after **August 20**. The link takes you to Tyler's Versatrans e-Link site.

The User Name is the first two letters of the child's last name, followed by the first four letters of the child's last name. The Password is the child's 8-digit birth date with no dashes or slashes. For example, John Doe, with a birth date of April 1, 1999 would have a User Name of dojh. The Password would be 04011999.

Once you have logged into the e-Link site, click on the "student" tab for information. Please wait until August 20 to try this.

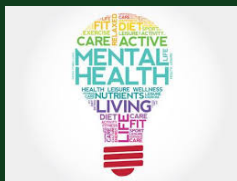
