Vaccine Update: Amy Cenci, one of our parents who is also a nurse, provided this information about vaccinations: *CCHMC has a vaccine clinic every Wednesday (4:30-7:30) and Saturday (8-12) at the main hospital. The Liberty campus has different days and times. People can make an appointment online or walk in. If you're thinking of getting your child vaccinated in time for Christmas, the first dose (Children 5-11, and anyone over 12) needs to happen by November 20, and the second dose by December 11. Full immunity follows two weeks after (Dec. 25).

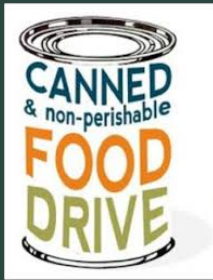
