Dear Parents and Guardians,

PICTURE DAY IS TOMORROW!

Students who are dressing up for pictures must dress appropriately for school. A few dress code reminders:

- No T-shirts, shirts with slogans, short shirts (belly showing), halter tops, spaghetti straps or peek-a-boo shoulders. Polo shirts, dress shirts or blouses, or sweater tops may be worn.
- No cut-offs, athletic shorts or pants, or torn shorts, skirts, or slacks (including those with fashion tears); no yoga pants. Leggings may not be worn as pants, but may be worn under a skirt or dress.



- All skirts, dresses or shorts must be modest in length. Please be careful about this. Many of the "flowy" skirts and pencil skirts being sold have hems 6"-8" above the knee. This is too short. Long or short leggings may be worn under these skirts if needed. Most fashion shorts sold for girls and teens are too short for Catholic school.
- Jeans **may** be worn as long as they are clean, in good repair, and worn at the waist.
- Sandals with an enclosed heel or heel strap may be worn.
- No high heels or fashion boots.

If your student is wearing a school or scouting uniform for Picture Day, we will issue out-of-uniform passes for Monday. On Monday, students with out-of-uniform passes may wear Saber wear, class t-shirts, t-shirts without slogans or images, casual shorts or skirts of a modest length, jeans, athletic pants/shorts of modest length and worn at the waist. Regular school shoes are worn on Monday.
