## Check Email for Gradelink Login Info

If you are new to our school, or your child is new to the school, you'll need to set up his or her account in Gradelink. Gradelink is our attendance, grading, and and notification system. You can set alerts to be notified when your student receives a particular grade, has an attendance issue, or receives discipline points. It is through Gradelink that emails are sent as well as text messages. When you log into your child's Gradelink account, click on the instructional video link for more information.

## **Set up your Titan Account for school lunches.**

Lunches are provided through West Clermont School District and are made on our premises. **Lunches are \$3.00 this year.** 

To set up your account, you will need your child's school ID number. This is the same ID number seen on your child's Gradedlink page.

You should be able to create your Titan account and load the PaySchool account, too. AND you should be able to apply for free or reduced priced lunches.



Dear Parents and Guardians,

We had a great day! None of our teachers cried, and everyone got where they belonged! Some nuts and bolts reminders:

Water bottles: Students need to bring a water bottle to school. We will be

activating the drinking spouts on our fountains eventually, but in general, it is advisable for students to have a water bottle at school - particularly in hotter weather.

**Snacks:** Snacks from home are a MUST for students in grades K-2. They take a snack and recess break everyday at 10:00, and do not eat lunch until 12:15. Please make sure your child has snack each day. Students in grade 3 snack at their desks mid-morning while reading or doing other independent work. Please pack one from home. Students in grades 3-5 eat lunch at 11:50. Students who are staying for a club or sport need a snack, too. Snacks are provided at latch key.

#### **Dropping Off and Picking Up:**

Students may be dropped off in the parking lot at the orange cones. Please make sure your child can exit independently on the <u>right side</u> of the car. If you need or want to help your child out of the car, please park behind the gym and walk between the storage sheds and the cafeteria onto the playground. *Do not park in the main parking lot in the morning.* 

Car-riders are released by grade level in the afternoon. Parents must exit the car and escort your student to your vehicle. Students in grades 6-8 are released from the modular, and may walk directly out to the playground. Those without younger siblings should be met by their parents on the playground, in front of the shelter. Parking behind the gym is most convenient for this age group. Younger students will be released from the main doors and parents can meet them on the school side of the orange cones, along with any older children in the family.

Students may not play on the playground after school unless a parent is with them.

#### **Lunch Information**

Students may choose from the following when buying lunches:

Parents need to set up a Titan account and a PaySchools account. Load the account with amount of money you choose. Your child will have a lunch account card with a corresponding account number that will be in the homeroom each morning. When the teacher takes attendance, lunch counts will also be taken. Children may order an extra entree in the morning, but should not expect to be able to take food that has not been ordered that morning. The cafeteria staff works hard to prepare what is needed, so pre-ordering each morning is necessary.
