Dear Parents and Guardians,

Last night's spring concert and art show were wonderful examples of your child's growth, creativity, and joy! I hope you enjoyed the evening as much as I did. My thanks go out to Mrs. Lana and Mrs. Nickles for all of their leadership.

I mentioned last night that we have another fine arts production coming up. **Honk! Jr.** Is a delightful musical, retelling the story of The Ugly Duckling. The curtain time is 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 20, and 2 p.m. on Sunday, May 21. Tickets are a free will offering.

Students will see our dress rehearsal tomorrow afternoon, but we may not get to the end before it's time for dismissal, and you'll want to see the end! I hope you can plan to attend.

Next Monday morning at 8:05 we will have our Window Evacuation drill. This drill is meant to give our teachers and students some confidence in their ability to escape a classroom if going out into the hallway would not be safe. We use carpet squares to smooth out the window sill, and sometimes a chair outside the window to provide a softer landing. Parents who are able to be here that morning can assist us! You would either be supervising the exit from the window, or rewarding our escapees with a life saver at their rally point. It's a super fast drill, and a popular one with the children.

Following the window evacuations, we'll meet in the gym to lay the groundwork for another safety drill. This one will be more along the lines of an intruder drill or some other scenario where the situation is fluid requiring alternate forms of communication with teachers, and independent thinking about the best response for their classes.

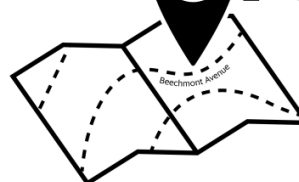

You May Be Eligible

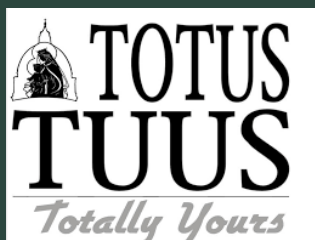

If you or your child is exposed to someone with COVID, wear a mask for 10 days. If symptoms develop, assume you are positive for COVID and start the isolation period. If you remain symptom free, test on Day 5. If the test is negative, finish out the remaining 5 days wearing a mask. If you test positive, begin your isolation period.

If a parent is positive, it is important to isolate away from your child(ren) at home, otherwise you continue to expose the child to COVID and the mask wearing will continue 10 days past your last date of infection. (yikes) Children who are close contacts should absolutely stay in school and stay masked for 10 days. Teachers will also be masked whenever they are a close contact.

We have a modest supply of rapid tests. Call the office if you need one.
