A Message from the Principal

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Our tour of the campus last week gave us some good ideas with regard to school safety. I hope a number of parents will be able to join us on

Monday, May 15 at 6:30 p.m. for a **Safety Information Night**. All parents/guardians are welcome. Officer Doerman will be giving parents an overview of ALICE* training, and fielding your questions about keeping children safe at school and in the community. I intend to share with parents whatever items are identified for upgrades so that you know where we are and where we are going with school safety. Follow-up meetings will be planned for those interested in assisting us with the upgrade efforts.

Safety preparations are not limited to improvements to the building or campus. It is

really important that our children know when to speak up, how to refuse someone else's bad idea, and how to ask for help. In addition to the Theology of the Body strand in our religion curriculum, we are launching the <u>Circle of Grace</u> program for our students in grades K-8. I'll be sending home a separate letter describing more about this program, which is required by the Archdiocese and which complements the SafeParish themes of keeping children safe. The age-appropriate lessons include a home component, too. We will cover this curriculum in the coming weeks and continue in the early fall next year so that students have a reminder close to this year's introduction, and can refer to the skills taught all year long.

Our Walk-a-thon is off to a great start! Last night's challenge was to upload Star Student videos to our site. Mrs. Schooley's Homeroom had the highest percent of students participate and they will get an extra recess! See the panel below for our stats so far, and the challenge for this weekend. 

To set up your account, you will need your child's school ID number. This is the same ID number seen on your child's Gradedlink page.




You May Be Eligible

Even families who <u>don't</u> receive government subsidies can be eligible for Free or Reduced Priced lunches. Go to your Titan account and click on "Meal Application." Click through the form until you are able to note your income or other qualifying circumstances. Although families receiving SNAP benefits are automatically eligible, they still have to apply every year. Make sure You should be able to create your <u>Titan account</u>, load the **PaySchool account** and <u>apply for</u> <u>free or reduced priced lunches.</u> you've taken advantage of this service, if you are able.

If you or your child is exposed to someone with COVID, wear a mask for 10 days. If symptoms develop, assume you are positive for COVID and start the isolation period. If you remain symptom free, test on Day 5. If the test is negative, finish out the remaining 5 days wearing a mask. If you test positive, begin your isolation period.

If a parent is positive, it is important to isolate away from your child(ren) at home, otherwise you continue to expose the child to COVID and the mask wearing will continue 10 days past your last date of infection. (yikes) Children who are close contacts should absolutely stay in school and stay masked for 10 days. Teachers will also be masked whenever they are a close contact. *We have a modest supply of rapid tests. Call the office if you need one.*
